APPLICATION FOR LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION WITH WILL ANNEXED NOT GRANTED FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- 1. Evidence is required to justify the issue of, and the necessity for, a grant showing more than one name. See *Dobbie* 27.58.3.
- 2. The basis for an entitlement to a grant of the order sought is the applicants' beneficial interest under the will. there is no mention of this in paragraph 2 of the application nor any evidence of this provided in the affidavit. Paragraph 2(b) of the application and 6 of the affidavit are of no relevance whatsoever. See the *Dobbie* precedent forms
- 3. Paragraph 7 of the affidavit does not state by what means the notices were given to the other beneficiaries. Why were their consents not sought?
- 4. Evidence will have to be provided as to why evidence of due execution of the will cannot be obtained and counsel should file a memorandum containing submissions why the doctrine of *omnia praesumunter rite esse acta* should be applied in this case.
- 5. The statement in the exhibit notes on the will that the deponents are seeking a grant "as trustees named in the will" is incorrect. The correct statement is the basis for the entitlement to the grant that should have been stated in paragraph 2 of the application. In this case, "...as one of the residuary beneficiaries named in the will..." To be corrected and initialled by solicitor who has signed them.

Reference is made to the Minute of Registrar Earles at Wellington dated 16 October 2013.

SIMON HENRY NUGENT STAMERS-SMITH a Consultant from Cruickshank Pryde's Queenstown Office spoke to MAREE LAMONT one of the witnesses to the signing of the will of the deceased in December 2010. Mrs Lamont and the other witness to the will, DEBORAH C CLARKE, were both Bank Officers at the Bank of New Zealand at the time the will was signed. Mrs Lamont advises that she was often asked to witness a range of documents, including wills, while she worked for the Bank but she has no specific recollection of witnessing this particular will.

Philip Bruce McDonald Counsel for the Applicant spoke to MAREE LAMONT on 28 November 2013. Mrs Lamont reiterated what she had told Mr Simon Nugent Stamers-Smith. She further said that Deborah Clarke was a Personal Banker at BNZ Nelson Branch. She believes the deceased would have been Deborah Clarke's client. It was common for the Personal Bankers to get other staff to witness documents with them. This was always done in the

presence of the client. Our firm has endeavoured to locate <u>DEBORAH C</u>

<u>CLARKE</u> the other witness to the will but we have been unable to locate her.

The doctrine of *omnia praesumuntur rite esse acta* (all things are presumed to have been done correctly) is relied upon to overcome the absence of an attestation clause in the will. It is respectfully submitted that the advice from **MAREE LAMONT**, one of the witnesses to the will, that documents were signed in the Bank in the presence of the client and two Bank Officers is sufficient evidence that the witnessing requirements would have been carried out correctly.



I am the partner in Cruickshank Pryde's Invercargill office who looks after the firms Estate files. I have been assisting Simon Stamers-Smith (from our Queenstown office) in regard to your late mother's file.

I understand Simon recently forwarded you a consent form which, if signed, gives your consent to Marc and Chris being appointed as the administrators in your late mother's Estate.

I further understand from Simon that there may be some reluctance on your part to sign those consent forms.

By way of background, as you are aware, we had initially tried to obtain probate of your mother's earlier Will. Your brother Christopher was reluctant to allow that to happen and after taking advice from an expert at the High Court it seems we are able to apply to have administrators appointed to administer your mother's later Will. That is, therefore, what we now need to do. In terms of that Will the children living in New Zealand at the date of your Mother's death are to be appointed to administer the Will.

Having Christopher and Marc appointed as administrators does not change how matters will be progressed after administration is granted. Assets in the Estate will be realised and the moneys invested. No distributions will be made until either all parties agree or a Court has made Orders in relation to the distribution of the Estate. The administrators individually will not have the ability to have access to those moneys except to pay verifiable Estate debts.

I should therefore be pleased if you could sign the consent forms, which are again attached, and scan the signed forms back to me within, say, a week of today's date and post the originals as soon as possible. The originals will have to be attached to the affidavit that Marc and Christopher need to sign.

If you do not agree to sign the consent forms, then I anticipate that our instructions will be to proceed to apply to have Christopher and Marc appointed as administrators in the absence of that consent. There is a process that allows that to occur. In that case, you do have the ability to object to that process and you may wish to take your own independent legal advice in regard

to that. Should we be able to assist in referring you to someone in that regard, please let me know. From my perspective, the best way forward is to get to a point where administration has been granted, the assets are brought into the Estate and frozen, and the parties can set about trying to settle matters or issue Court proceedings if that becomes necessary.

Please feel free to contact me directly to discuss any issues raised above. I look forward to receiving the consents or hearing from you in the very near future.
